WATCH

This week's video is about when Jesus choose His 12 disciples. Once your child watches the video, take time to review the questions below to help them understand that we can be helpers, just like the helpers that Jesus chose to follow Him!

CONNECTING THE DOTS

- 1. What is God's Word? (the Bible)
- 2. Jesus saw two men by the water. What were they doing? (fishing)
- 3. What were the men's names? (Peter & Andrew)
- 4. What did Jesus say to them? (Come follow me)
- 5. What were the names of the next two men that Jesus saw? (John & James)
- 6. Then Jesus saw a tax/money collector. What was his name? (Matthew)
- 7. How many helpers did Jesus have all together? (12)
- 8. What did these helpers do? (Tell others about Jesus)
- 9. Do you think you can be a helper to and tell others about Jesus? (allow child to answer)

A fun way to reinforce the big idea from today is to go over the hand motions from the lesson. We have included a picture (below) to help remind your child.

I (thumbs to chest)

Can Help (hands out, palms up)

Jesus! (point up)




WORDS TO REMEMBER
