The Woman at the Well – John 4: 3-32

Big Idea

Jesus Loves Me!

Materials Needed

3 sheets of white copy paper, scissors



WATCH

This week's video is about the woman at the well. Once your child watches the video, take time to review the questions below to help them understand that even though we are all different, Jesus knows and loves each of us so much!



CONNECTING THE DOTS

1. What is God's Word? *(the Bible)*
2. In the story today did Jesus run away from the lady at the well or did he stay and talk to her? *(He talked to her)*
3. Was the woman scared or amazed that Jesus knew so much about her?
(Amazed)
4. Does Jesus only love people that are just like Him or does He love everyone?
(everyone)
5. Who do we need to believe in to become a part of God's family? *(Jesus)*

A fun way to reinforce the big idea from today is to go over the hand motions from the lesson. We have included a picture (below) to help remind your child.

Jesus *(point up)*

Loves *(hug self)*

Me! *(thumbs to chest)*



WORDS TO REMEMBER

HAVE FUN TOGETHER

Craft: Unique snowflakes

Supplies: 3 pieces of white copy paper, scissors
